What is our present understanding of human auditory perception? Consider if the way we work encourages a false dichotomy of knowledge.

How can education work to bring the artistic and technical approaches together and apply some of the technical things we know on the artistic side. How can the artistic side of the business needs and wants be expressed usefully to the technical side?

JJ proposes to address such issues as "mix buss performance" claims and the performance of various processors (some of which are quite nonlinear, for good reason). It is his hope that we can continue to use understanding of perception, which will help create the "really here" immersive understanding that is the goal of the realists, the "you could never be here but you wish you could" sensation of the avant-garde, and encourage the delivery systems of the world to "get with the program" rather than diving willy-nilly to the lowest common denominator.
