

Horizons and Boundaries

Boundaries have an opponent on the other side and require energy to maintain. Horizons present previously unknown opportunities.

Over several decades of research, Steve arrived at a set of Seven Horizons of Music Decentralized, the first of which was realized by <u>Roon Labs</u> on September 20, 2022. This was when they came out with their Roon 2.0 offering, unintentionally providing a path to personal and private streaming services - where instead of few one-to-many music distribution services, now we are afforded many one-to-one opportunities to share our music or any other audio we may care to share.

Roon, a Metadata Utility



Like power and water services with many power plants and sources that are combined and presented as a single source at your location, Roon licenses and aggregates metadata sources, and wraps your personal music collection (as well as Tidal and Qobuz streaming services) into a single integrated presentation.

With Roon 2.0, Roon has come out with their ARC service – allowing anyone with a Roon account to open their personal collection files and metadata to the outside world on a very limited basis. These could be a collection of songs, books on tape, lectures - whatever one wishes to share personally and privately with friends and fans on a one to one basis, in High Resolution audio with no third party interference in how the art is presented.

The First Horizon

In this meeting we'll explore the first of seven horizons of Music Decentralized, realized by Roon ARC – and touch upon the visions of the future horizons. We'll show an example of a fully formed and functional streaming service.

For those playing along at home, please download and install <u>Roon ARC</u> on your phone prior to the meeting. We'll give usernames and passwords out in private chat for you to experience our personal and private streaming service, and you can continue to listen after the meeting!
