“What’s New in Audio Integrated Circuits”

DIRECTIONS: From I-5, take the N.E. 45th street exit eastbound, toward the University of Washington. Turn south on Roosevelt, 3 blocks east of the freeway (one way street). Go south on Roosevelt for two blocks. Limited parking is available next to the JSP building, otherwise, park on the streets.

Hank Zumbahlen, Sr. Field Applications Engineer for Analog Devices will discuss the current direction of audio integrated circuits. He will cover computer audio (multimedia) codecs as well as other higher performance audio converters. He will also discuss the Asynchronous Sample rate converters, which have been getting a lot of press lately. Also on the agenda is a discussion of a new multi-bit Sigma-Delta DAC.

Finally, he will discuss a new application note that is being written on an outboard DAC for use in high-end systems. The design uses the AD1891 Sample Rate Converter as well as many tweaks in the audio section.

Note: The promised tour of the new Symetrix facility has been postponed.
